Greetings from SIS...

We hope that you and all members in the family are safe and in good health.

We are pleased to inform you that the Ministry of Education and Higher Education has announced that the opening of all schools, including Kindergartens, for the Academic year 2020-21 will take place in three phases.

Phase-1

September 1 to September 3 One third of Student will attend the school	Objective Students will be trained to adapt to the new environment.

Phase 2

September 6 to September 10 First batch of 50% students in a class will attend school while others will stay at home. September 13 to September 17 The next batch of 50% students will attend school while the first batch will stay at home. Online teaching will be continued for the students assigned to stay home	Objective Students will be trained to adapt to the blended learning system.

Phase 3

Third Phase will start on 20/09/2020. As per The Ministry of Education and Higher Education instruction, The school will function with 100% attendance.	All School Process will be resumed based on the Health Protocols.

- School time for Phase 1 and Phase 2: **07:00 am to 10.00 am for the classes KG-I and KG-II.**
- School time for Phase 1 and Phase 2: **07:00 am to 12:25 pm from classes I to XII.**
- The class teacher will inform the day allotted for each student for Phase 1 and Phase 2.
- Maximum efforts are made to accommodate siblings to attend on the same day.
- Students are advised to report to their respective classroom.
- Attendance will be given for non-attending days during Phase 1 and Phase 2.

SIS is committed to ensure all precautionary measures as instructed by the Ministry of Health and Safety, and in coordination with the Ministry of Public Health.

- Students are asked to bring their own food, drinking water bottles, personal hygiene materials (personal sanitizer, additional masks and tissue boxes).
- Parents are requested to strictly adhere to sending nutritious food only for children during the recess.
- Canteen will not function. There will be no arrangements for bringing outside food.
- Parents are advised to send water bottles for their wards. Students will be allowed to refill their water bottles from drinking water spots in a controlled way
- Students are requested to wear their Mask at all times.

Arrival of Privately Transported Students

- Please use gate no: 2 and gate no: 5 for dropping your wards
- All gates will be closed at 07:00 am. No students will be allowed inside after 07:00 am.
- Requested to drop the children at the allotted gates before 7.00 am.
- Security at the gate will check the student body temperature with a contactless device. (Students above temperature of 38 degree Celsius will be sent back home).

Dispersal of Privately Transported Students

- Parents are requested not to occupy the school transport parking space before 12.45 pm.
- All gates will be used for school transported students from 12.25 pm to 12:45 pm.
- Parents are requested to approach the designated gates to collect your wards only after 12.45 pm. The privately transported students will be sent from classes only after 12.45 pm.
- Parents are requested to receive your ward from the designated gates between 12.45 pm to 1.00 pm. Class teachers will inform about the designated gates.
- Parents are requested to avoid traffic inconvenience at the dispersal point.

Arrival and Dispersal of Privately Transported Students -KG

- Please use gate no: 12 to drop your wards before 07:00 am.
- Parents are requested to approach through gate no: 12 after 10:15 am during dispersal.
- Dispersal process of school transported students will start at 10:00 am.
